



The Reception topic for Summer 2 is 'All Around the World'.

Literacy Children will continue to follow the Read Write Inc scheme to develop and embed children's phonetic knowledge. Please continue to read, practise sounds, and read tricky words by sight with your child at home to consolidate learning.

Children will learn to plan what they want to write. We will apply our phonic knowledge when writing a two-part sentence, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

We will read a range of fiction and non-fiction books that link to our 'All Around the World' topic, learning new words that we can use in our play.

Mathematics

In mathematics we will explore the composition of numbers, practise automatically recalling number bonds to ten and subtraction facts to 5.

We will use Numicon when exploring doubles and odd and even numbers. We will continue to learn to write numerals to create number sentences.

The children will look for, name and describe 3D shapes in the environment.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This half term we will encourage children to become confident to try new activities and show independence, resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge in preparation for Year 1.

Our SCARF learning will focus on 'Growing and Changing' where we will learn to talk about our bodies and how we are changing.



Expressive Arts & Design

This half-term the children are learning to safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. Children will share their creations, explaining the process they have used.

When being imaginative, children will invent and recount stories with their friends, perform songs, rhymes and poems.

Understanding the World

In understanding of the world, we will talk about how environments can be different to the one we live in.

We will focus our learning on changes of state and will explore this through water, jelly and chocolate. Children will make ice lollies and chocolate rice crispy buns to consolidate their learning.

Communication and Language

The children will listen to and understand what has been taught in non-fiction books, learning new vocabulary demonstrating their understanding of the vocabulary by using it in a range of contexts.

After our science experiments, children will explain why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from non-fiction books.

Physical Development

PE will be on a Wednesday morning for both Reception classes.

Sports coaches will continue to lead the sessions, this half term we will be focusing on movement, speed and space.

Please ensure children bring PE kits every Wednesday and have outdoor trainers or pumps and wear sun cream as some sessions may be held outside.
