

Physical Development

When reading the story 'Topsy and Tim visit the Dentist' we will discuss the importance of brushing our teeth and work together to sort healthy and non-healthy foods. Children will spend time sorting foods to create a healthy lunch.

The children will practise controlling their movements on scooters, bikes and climbing frames.

Mathematics

In mathematics we will be exploring all about patterns.
